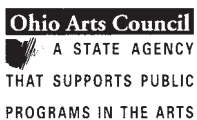

DVAC will continue to mount "Short Shows" during the 2011-2012 season in the front of the gallery, between scheduled exhibitions. "Short Shows" allow our members to present new, innovative concepts, projects or bodies of work in a less formal manner, often designed to foster interaction between the artist and the public. These shows are perfect for unusual installations, in-process bodies of work and interactive media and are presented in the storefront of the space, with participating artists present in the gallery for agreed-upon hours during the exhibit. Begin by emailing a paragraph-long explanation of your idea by Aug. 6, 6 p.m. to [pmauk@daytonvisualarts.org](mailto:pmauk@daytonvisualarts.org). Up to 10 of those who propose by email will be asked to give a 10-minute presentation to a panel on Thursday, Aug. 11.
